



## Resolution in Support of CSU Electronic Core Collection Funding

**WHEREAS** the ASCSU resolution, *Increased Funding for the Electronic Core Collection (ECC)*, was passed unanimously by the Academic Senate of the California State University (ASCSU) on January 17-18, 2019 ([AS-3351-18/FGA/AA \(Rev\)](#)), and recommends increased financial support for the CSU ECC, and

**WHEREAS** the ASCSU resolution calls attention to the increased benefits and cost savings due to centralized funding through the Chancellor's Office (CO), and

**WHEREAS** a strong ECC is essential to the academic endeavors of faculty and students and to student success, and
